Celebration of National "Bastille" Day 2019 in France

The Indian Diaspora Council International (IDC) congratulates the people of France on the 230th anniversary of Bastille Day, the La Fête Nationale, commemorating the day in 1789 when crowds stormed the Bastille, a fortress used as a prison in Paris. The event marks the beginning of the French Revolution and honours democracy and equality in France.



The storming of Bastille on 14th July 1798 sent a signal to the French monarchy that the French people were embracing the revolution's motto, liberté, égalité, fraternité, or liberty, equality and brotherhood. The riot was a call for the establishment of a republic in France in the face of an oppressive regime and food shortages that spurred on the revolution.
