Passing of Smt Sushma Swaraj, India's former Minister of External Affairs

The Indian Diaspora Council International (IDC) is saddened at the news of the passing of **Smt Sushma Swaraj**, prominent Indian politician and former Minister of External Affairs in charge of Indian Diaspora matters from 2014 thru' 2019 during the first term of Prime Minister Narendra Modi's government. Smt Sushma Swaraj was the second woman to hold the office of India's Minister of External Affairs after the late Indira Gandhi.

Smt Sushma Swaraj was born on February 14, 1952 in Haryana passed away in New Delhi, India on August 6, 2019 at the age of 67 years.



Smt Sushma Swaraj suffered a cardiac arrest on Tuesday, August 6, 2019 according to news reports. She was a popular minister in PM Narendra Modi's first term as prime minister, but she did not contest parliamentary elections earlier this year. She became known for helping Indians stuck abroad by responding to them on various matters of urgency and need. Smt Sushma Swaraj had been suffering from poor health and had a kidney transplant in 2016.

The news of her death prompted an outpouring of grief and condolences from fellow politicians and from Indians in India and worldwide.
