IDC Statement in Article - NY GUYANESE URGE TO VOTE IN TUESDAY'S PRIMARY By Vishnu Bisram



Ashook Ramsaran, Guyanese born president of the Indian Diaspora Council (IDC) states that:

"Voting is the optimum form of civic engagement and political participation, providing a rewarding sense of citizenship with enormous benefits to their communities such as funding for schools and other community needs based on population and voting participation.

"Voting is a privilege, an entrenched constitutional right for which many have struggled and sacrificed for that right to choose his/her representative in elected office.

"While some areas of the country are struggling with voting rights, voting in NYC is free of those encumbrances. The right to vote is a unique privilege as a citizen and a meaningful example to families and younger generations, especially among immigrant families. Those who vote can have legitimate reasons to complain afterwards when policies may not be favorable to one's preferences.

"So we urge every registered voter to vote for the candidates of your choice."
